GRANT MANAGEMENT SERVICE AGREEMENT

3. Grant Applicant's Responsibilities

- 3.1. Grant Applicant must provide Contractor with all requested information required to prepare a completed application no later than August 1, 2024, twenty-nine (29) days prior to the grant deadline, which is August 30, 2024
- 3.2. Provide contractor with Engineer contact information.

4. Compensation

For the services provided under this Agreement, Contractor's fee will be based upon award which will be a fee of 10% of project, but no more than \$9,500.00.

5. Term and Termination

This Agreement shall commence on the date of execution and shall remain in effect until the services outlined herein are completed, unless terminated earlier by either party upon thirty (30) days' written notice to the other party.

6. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, and communications, whether written or oral, relating to the subject matter hereof.
